- If a homeowner needs to sign for Homestead Exemption, our office will mail the letter to the address on the sale filed in the Clerk of Court's Office.
- If a homeowner wants to sign for a special level assessment freeze, please wait until we are allowing walk-ins.
- If you are needing a property bond, please call our office at 985-876-6620 and make an appointment to obtain your letter.
- All April 1st deadlines involving documentation that must be provided to the Assessor's Office will be extended until May 1st.
